There will be a 'Drum-Major Retreat' on the track at the conclusion of the Prelims. Each participating band will receive an Area Plaque, and the bands advancing to the Finals will be announced.

The Finals will begin directly after the Directors' meeting and the Drum-Majors' Retreat. The first band in the Finals will warm-up at the gate (ready position) and will receive their full 30 minute warm-up. The rest of the bands will go to the warm-up areas, and will be provided with a warm-up schedule.

At the conclusion of the Finals, there will be another Directors' meeting in the press-box to review the results. There will also be another Drum-Major Retreat. The drum-majors will be presented an Area Finalist Plaque, and the bands certified to the State Marching Contest will be announced.
