

**CONTEST ENTRY PROCEDURES
REGION 21 UIL MUSIC**

SOLO & ENSEMBLE CONTEST Entry Procedure
(Instrumental (band/orch.) & Vocal)

Go to www.uilforms.com/regions/21/ – **REGION “ON-LINE ENTRY”** and follow instructions

ENTRY FEE:

\$7.00 for each Soloist and **\$7.00** per member for each ensemble (i.e. a quartet would cost \$28). The online Invoice/Statement will automatically compute your fee.

LATE ENTRY FEE (if accepted):

\$14.00 for each Soloist and **\$14.00** per member for each ensemble (i.e. a quartet would cost \$56). The Invoice/Statement will automatically compute your fee.

NOTE: Only high school students (grades 9-12) may enter this contest (there are some exceptions for ensembles – see the **UIL C & CR**)

NOTE: Students entering **PIANO SOLOS** must enter with their **PARENT ORGANIZATION**; i.e., if you are in band only, you must enter your piano solo and attend contest when the band enters and performs; if you are in choir only, you must enter your piano solo and perform when the choir solo & ensemble contest is held. If you are in both organizations, you may choose the date you wish to perform, **but you may enter only once on piano.**

You will enter this contest through our web site, using your log-in name and password. You may access your entries to review or edit using your log-in name and password up to the contest entry deadline. The Region Executive Secretary will print all comment sheets and UIL form #9, and deliver them to the contest site.

WHAT TO MAIL (On or before the entry deadline): *On-line entry will generate comment sheets 6, 7, 8, and the #9.*

1. One Form #1 (signed by your Principal of Superintendent), listing the **entire** eligible membership of the competing organization alphabetically, must be in the hands of the Contest Chairman before your students perform. All eligible students must be listed whether they enter solo & ensemble events or not. It is not necessary to mail these forms in with your other forms and fees;
2. Completed “Schedule Request Form” (on webpage) [if needed];
3. Contest Invoice/Statement (included in Region UIL “ONLINE ENTRY”);
4. A “School Check” or District PURCHASE ORDER/REQUISITION for entry fees.

NOTE: After the seven day deadline prior to the first day of the Contest, titles of solos, ensembles, or movements to be performed may not be changed.
