

**CONTEST ENTRY PROCEDURES
REGION 21 UIL MUSIC**

TWIRLING SOLO & ENSEMBLE Entry Procedure

Go to www.uilforms.com/regions/21/ – **REGION “ON-LINE ENTRY”** and follow instructions

ENTRY FEE:

\$7.00 for each Soloist and **\$7.00** per member for each ensemble (i.e. a quartet would cost \$28). The online Invoice/Statement will automatically compute your fee.

LATE ENTRY FEE (if accepted):

\$14.00 for each Soloist and **\$14.00** per member for each ensemble (i.e. a quartet would cost \$56). The Invoice/Statement will automatically compute your fee.

NOTE: Only high school students (grades 9-12) may enter this contest (there are some exceptions for ensembles – see the **UIL C & CR**). There is competition in Class I, or Class III (9th. Grade only) events.

You will enter this contest through our web site, using your log-in name and password. You may access your entries to review or edit using your log-in name and password up to the contest entry deadline. The Region Executive Secretary will print all comment sheets and UIL Form #9, and deliver them to the contest site.

WHAT TO MAIL (On or before the entry deadline): *On-line entry will generate comment sheets and the #9.*

1. One Form #1 (signed by your Principal of Superintendent), listing the **entire** eligible membership of the competing organization alphabetically, must be in the hands of the Contest Chairman before your students perform. All eligible students must be listed whether they enter solo-ensemble events or not. It is not necessary to mail this form in with your other forms and fees;
8. Contest Invoice/Statement (included in Region UIL “ONLINE ENTRY”);
9. A “School Check” or District PURCHASE ORDER/REQUISITION for entry fees.

Note: Twirling Solos & Ensembles may be performed with or without musical accompaniment; however, if recordings are used, **you must furnish your own sound equipment.**
